STEPS ON APPLYING

 CHECK LIST OF APPROVED SCHOOLS FOR YOUR MAJOR AT http://www.kuwaitculture.com/University/listing.asp

STEP 1 • SELECT AT LEAST FIVE (5) SCHOOLS

STEP 2

- CHECK THE ADMISSIONS WEBSITE OF FACH SCHOOL SELECTED.
- REVIEW THE ADMISSION PROCEDURES / REQUIREMENTS / DEADLINES (SEE NOTES FOR COMMON **REQUIREMENTS)**
- INFORM YOUR CULTURAL DIVISION ADVISOR OF YOUR INTENDED SCHOOLS

STEP 3

- COMPLETE THE ON-LINE APPLICATION FORM
- PAY APPLICATION FEE AND SUBMIT APPLICATION FORM

STEP 4

- INFORM YOUR CULTURAL DIVISION ADVISER OF YOUR APPLICATIONS AND REQUEST TO SEND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS TO THE UNIVERISTIES
- GIVE THE APPLICATION NO. OR REFERENCE NO. TO YOUR CULTURAL DIVISION ADVISOR
- CONTACT TOEFL/IELTS FOR YOUR OFFICIAL SCORE TO BE SENT DIRECTLY TO THE SCHOOLS

STEP 5

- CHECK YOUR E-MAIL FOR CONFIRMATION AND FOLLOW UP ON MISSING DOCUMENTS (Most schools have live chats or 800 numbers available for any inquiries)
- CHECK APPLICATION STATUS WITH UNIVERSITY

- Check the list either by major or by university name
- Be sure to check that your program is approved for the bachelor 's level (indicated by B)

Select at least five (5) schools

- do not rely on one school for admission, you need to have back up options
- consider the following things when selecting school –admissibility, requirements, cost of living, safety, weather, etc.

- **x** Check the admissions website of each school selected and review the following: <u>sample</u>
 - admission procedures
 - requirements
 - deadlines
- **Most Common Requirements:**
 - Official TOELF/IELTS Score scores must be sent directly by TOEFL/IELTS to the university
 - High School transcript (in English)
 - University transcripts from previous universities attended (i.e., Kuwait Univ./AUK/GUST)
 - Letters of Recommendation —usually written by high school teacher/counselor/principal
 - Personal Essay
 - Copy of Passport/U.S. visa/current I-20
 - Medical /Immunization Records
- **Deadlines:** Each school has a different deadline, you will have to check each university; in most schools the tentative deadlines are:

FALL admission - February deadline

SPRING admission –October deadline

Apply at least 1-2 months before the deadline; this will give you time to submit requirements

Inform your Cultural Division advisor of your intended /applied schools

Select application for undergraduate, first-year, international students

<u>Sample</u>

- Complete the on-line application form
 - Answer all questions
 - Educational History provide detailed history for example, if you attended any university after high school in Kuwait or anywhere else (it is illegal not to provide this information)
 - Certificate of Financial Responsibility you must sign this page and submit it to your Cultural Division advisor
- × Pay application fee you need to pay the fee for your application to be processed
- Make sure you receive an e-mail confirmation from the university that they received your application

Take note of the application number/reference no or ID no. assigned to you

- Inform your Cultural Division Advisor of the application you have submitted and request to send the supporting documents
- Give the application no./reference no or ID number of your application or forward the confirmation e-mail to your adviser with your comments
- Contact <u>TOEFL</u> / <u>IELTS</u> for your official score to be sent directly to the schools scores are considered official only if it is received by the university directly from IELTS/TOEFL

- Check your e-mail to make sure that the school received your application or if there are missing documents for your application
- Universities will inform you of any additional documents required for your application
- You can also check the status of your application by going to the university admission website and by logging on to your account at the university <u>sample</u>
